TELEPHONE CONFERENCE

REMARKS: Parties appear by telephone; defendants not present. Discussion held regarding current special trial setting of February 23, 2010. Counsel for Johnson filed a motion to continue the trial setting to the May trial docket; counsel for Solomon joins that motion and the government has no objection. Counsel for Elder opposes the continuance but understands he has no speedy trial argument. The court advised that it has discussed the continuance request with Judge Gaitan and Judge Gaitan is inclined to grant a continuance. The court believes that Judge Gaitan may be available to try the case beginning June 1, but that would allow only nine days for trial. Parties state that they believe the case can be tried in nine days. The court suggests to the parties that they get together and discuss stipulations and trial documents and then report back to the court.

Discussion held regarding pretrial motion deadlines. Counsel for Johnson requests pretrial motions be filed by February 12, 2010.

Discussion held regarding the outstanding motion to transfer and follow-up regarding the Texas investigation. Counsel for Solomon and government counsel provide a brief update.
